<b>General Tips</b>  <i>Be sure to attend info sessions and meet with the university advisors prior to applying.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Plan to complete Praxis I (PPST), required courses, and field experience preferably a couple of months before the application deadline.</li> <li>-Incorporate Math 111 and Math 112; MUS 253 or another UHM approved DA course; ED 297S/ED 284 and articulated courses into your AAT degree.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Plan to complete Praxis I (PPST) by the end of your first semester at UHWO.</li> <li>-To maximize your transfer credits, be sure to work with your advisor.</li> <li>--Students may consider being dual-enrolled at UHWO and LCC in your last semester at LCC.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Plan to complete your Praxis I (PPST) prior to entering Chaminade (but by end of 1st quarter at latest).</li> <li>-Refer to Chaminade’s “Hawaii Community Colleges Transfer Guide” at <a href="http://www.chaminade.edu">www.chaminade.edu</a> to ensure you incorporate general education courses that transfer to Chaminade.</li> </ul>
